- 1. CCR- Stephanie Martinez

 - a. DEIC Members were paired to work on the Student Code of Conduct. Each group was assigned a different section. They compared the TASB model to the current CISD version of the Student Handbook and Code of Conduct and made recommendations/suggestions for additions/deletions.

2. Curriculum Update- Dr. Ritchlin

Dr. Ritchlin reviewed the Curriculum Audit Timeline, which began with an audit in 2016-2017. A 5 year phased plan was then developed and implemented to ensure quality curriculum in all content areas.

3. Professional Learning- Dr. Ritchlin

Dr. Ritchlin reviewed the "Elevate CISD- Bringing Instruction to the Next Level" professional learning opportunity coming this summer for new teachers, teachers who joined the district during the last two years and experienced teachers looking for additional growth. The program is intended to support teacher retention. It provides teachers with a strong foundation for their classrooms, supports quality Tier 1 instruction, and equips teachers with the tools needed to start out strong in the new school year. Elevate CISD will include scenario based experiences, make and take for routines and procedures, exemplar instructional videos, and planning and practicing first day routines.
