BOARD ACTIONS

Approved the minutes of the **Regular Meeting** for **March 4**, **2024**.

Approved of the Joint Election Agreement and Contract for Election Services with Tarrant County Elections.

Approved of the 2024-2025 Certification of Provision of Instructional Materials.

School districts are required to certify annually to the State Board of Education and the commissioner that students have access to instructional materials covering all Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) for all required subjects, except physical education.

Approved the **District Auditor Renewal** for Hankins, Eastup, Deaton, Tonn and Seay to provide auditing services to Castleberry ISD for the 2024 fiscal year audit.

Approved the Tower Maintenance Renewal Agreement with Nokia.

The total of the proposed annual renewal is \$117,914. This amount reflects the pricing of the Nokia HGACBuy and DIR contracts.

Utilizing HGACBuy and DIR contracts for the recommended purchase meets the competitive bidding requirements for purchases greater than \$50,000.

Approved the Contract Renewals for Assistant Principals, Campus Academic Leaders, and Other Professionals.
